RESOLUTION # 5-5-87-A

- WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin is a federally recognized Indian government and a Treaty Tribe recognized by the laws of the United States, and
- WHEREAS, the Oneida General Tribal Council is the governmental body of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, and
- WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee has been delegated the authority of Article IV, Section 1 of the Oneida Tribal Constitution by the Oneida General Tribal Council, and
- WHEREAS, it is the goal of the Oneida Tribe to protect, maintain and improve the standard of living for it's members and the environment in which we live, as well as expanding our tribal land base, and
- WHEREAS, there is a shortage of tribal land available for housing needs
- NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: that the Tribal Loan Credit Program is hereby established to assist adult enrolled tribal members by providing the initial downpayment toward the purchase of real property for housing to upgrade the present standard of living contingent upon meeting the guidelines and the loan agreement as set forth by the Oneida Tribe, and
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Oneida Business Committee hereby adopts the Tribal Loan Credit Program and that this program be administered by approved procedures through the Oneida Land Office.
