Resolution # 5-16-89-B

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin is a federally recognized Indian government and a treaty tribe recognized by the laws of the United States, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida General Tribal Council is the governmental body of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee has been delegated the authority of Article IV, Section 1 of the Oneida Tribal Constitution by the Oneida General Tribal Council, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin is the owner of a parcel of land known as "Oneida Airport Land", Oneida Indian Reservation, Brown County, Wisconsin, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians has established the Oneida Bingo Enterprise, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Bingo Enterprise will construct a bingo hall building on part of the Oneida Airport Land, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin desires to lease that part of the Oneida Airport Land to the Oneida Bingo Enterprise for construction of the bingo hall building, such land more particularly described in the attached lease and incorporated by reference into this resolution.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Oneida Business Committee, in session assembled, hereby approves the lease with the Oneida Bingo Enterprise;
