RESOLUTION

JULY 7, 1939

1. That election of officers be held fourth Saturday in July.
2. That a caucus to nominate the candidates for different offices and committees be held on the second Saturday of July.
3. That the Secretary post names of candidates ten days prior to election.
4. That at a caucus, not more than five candidates shall be nominated for any office.
5. That the election be by secret ballot and therebe at least two polling places.
6. That the Executive Committee appoint an election board to conduct the election.
