**WHEREAS,** the Oneida General Tribal Council is the duly recognized governing body of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, and

**WHEREAS,** the Oneida Business Committee has been delegated the authority of Article IV, Section 1 of the Oneida Tribal Constitution by the Oneida General Tribal Council, and

**WHEREAS,** the Oneida Tribe has acquired in fee status the following parcel described as: Former J & G Olson Farms LLC Property at N8161 Olson Road and Cooper Road, and

**WHEREAS,** the parcel is described as follows:

**WHEREAS,** the above described parcel is requested in Trust Status to expand Oneida Tribal land base and provide an existing site for agricultural use, and

**WHEREAS,** the Oneida Business Committee certifies that the local property taxes will be paid up to trust placement, and

**WHEREAS,** prior resolution BC 12-07-05-J cited incorrect tax parcel,

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Oneida Business Committee hereby requests that the United States Bureau of Indian Affairs initiate and carry out the process required to place the above parcels in trust for the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Oneida Business Committee resolution 12-07-05-J is repealed.


