Mr. Whitney Skenandore was present at meeting on behalf of heirs and stated that he would be satisfied to rent the house for 1 month at \$15 per month beginning on the 26th day of Aug. so they could move in the house.

The committee expressed the opinion that they were satisfied if the heirs were. Mr. and Mrs. Adams were advised to contact the land commission and make application for the land before the next regular meeting so the council can act on it as that time.

Secretary read a letter from Stewart Udall about the plans for converting the Santa Fe Indian School into new institute of American Indian Arts.

Council advised Mr. & Mrs. Adams that they could pay the fees on land at special meeting when they get their loan.

No other business. Motion by Eva Danforth to adjourn, seconded by Althea Schuyler. Carried.
