WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin have a 17/30 undivided heirship interest in the Daniel S. Skenandoah allotment, Oneida allottee No. 1410, which allotment is described as Lot A, Section 28, and Lot 7, Section 29, both in Township 23 North, Range 19 East, Oneida Reservation, Outagamie County, Wisconsin, and


WHEREAS, this allotment has a stand of merchantable timber which should be managed so as to return a cash income to the allotment owners, and this timber stand presently contains mature, overmature, and defective timber which should be cut at this time,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the Superintendent of the Great Lakes Agency be requested and is hereby authorized to make a timber sale on this allotment as provided by paragraph 141.7, Title 25, Code of Federal Regulations, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chairman of the Oneida Executive Committee be herewith authorized to sign a Power of Attorney for sale of allotment timber, or any other necessary papers, authorizing the Superintendent, Great Lakes Agency to make a timber sale on this allotment as deemed necessary or desirable by the Branch of Forestry, Great Lakes Agency.
