
National Historical publications and Records Commission Resolution

- WHEREAS,** the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin is a federally recognized Indian government and a treaty tribe recognized by the laws of the United States, and
- WHEREAS,** the Oneida General Tribal Council is the governing body of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, and
- WHEREAS,** the Oneida Business Committee has been delegated the authority of Article IV, Section I of the Oneida Tribal Constitution by the Oneida General Tribal Council, and
- WHEREAS,** the Oneida Nation, has, as one of its highest priorities, the preservation of the Oneida history, culture and language, and
- WHEREAS,** the goal to produce and publish "A Photo History of the Oneida Nation of Wisconsin" may be accomplished through a grant from the National Historical Publications and Records Commission, and
- WHEREAS,** the researching, accumulating, documenting and organizing of documents and photographs will require two years of work and gathering from the respective institutional collections, and
- WHEREAS,** the production of the book and the microfilming of all documents will occur in year 2 of the project, and
- WHEREAS,** the Oneida Nation Cultural and Heritage Department now has lead staff to direct and support such a project, but requires additional funds for a research assistant and data entry clerk, as well as, equipment for reproduction and proper storage, and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: that the Oneida Business Committee fully supports this project and the correspondent application for funding in the amount of \$300,000.00 over a two year period beginning on February 1, 1999.
