RESOLUTION # 12-27-95-C

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin is a federally recognized Indian government and Treaty Tribe recognized by the laws of the United States, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida General Tribal Council is the governing body of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee has been delegated the authority of Article IV, Section of the Oneida Tribal Constitution by the Oneida General Tribal Council, and

WHEREAS, Robert J. Schuyler Sr., a Tribal member(s), of Lease Number RL-2697(95) more particularly described as follows:

Lot 6, Standing Stone Subdivision, a part of Indian Claim 151 and 147, Section 3, Township 23 North, Range 19 East, Town of Hobart, Brown County, Wisconsin, containing .37 acres, more or less, subject to all valid existing rights-of-way of record.

WHEREAS, Robert J. Schuyler Sr., Lessee(s), Tribal member(s) of said lease site wishes to modify lease number RL-2697(95) as follows:

Delete: Robert J. Schuyler Sr., a Tribal member


Insert: White Crow, a Tribal member
