### M I N U T E S

Meeting called to order by Chairman Julius Danforth.

Minutes of April 1, 1963 were read.

Motion made by Irene Moore to approve the minutes as read. Seconded by Althea Schuyler. Carried.

Treasurers report read as follows:

Tribal Fund: \$174.12

Rehab. Fund: \$489.00

Motion made by Eva Danforth to approve Treasurers report. Seconded by Irene Moore. Carried.

Mrs. Alfreda Branten was at meeting to inquire about the right-of-way by her assignment. Council advised her that the Ashland Agency would check into this matter, as her well is included in the land needed for the right-of-way. Julius Danforth said he had already advised the town that they would have to drill another well on this property.

Artley Skenandore was at meeting to inquire if there was any news concerning the meeting held on Public Housing in April. Secretary read a letter from Lawrence Kuzlowski advising us that the Organizational documents creating the Oneida Housing Authority had been transmitted to the area Director James E. Hawkins in Minneapolis, Minn. He also was advised that they would be notified when we had more information.

James Schuyler presented a land application for Nellie Cornelius.

Motion was made by Irene Moore to approve this land application. Seconded by Althea Schuyler. Carried.

Mrs. Cornelius said she would like to get an assignment on the former Charles B. Cornelius assignment if heirs of Charles were not interested in the land. (Part of this was assigned to Alice Cornelius Schuyler) Land committee was advised to stake out four plots for home-sites.

Motion was made by Irene Moore to notify children of Charles Cornelius as to plans for this land, and find out if they were interested in an assignment, other-wise it will be let out to someone else. Seconded by Althea Schuyler. Carried.

Motion was made by Irene Moore to approve a release signed by Austin Summers for 92 acres of land. Seconded by Althea Schuyler. Carried.

Council advised James Schuyler and Julius Danforth to stake out Austin Summers assignment for a 5 acre home-site.

Council discussed the enrollment of Isabelle Choteau Bain, as she is on the Oneida Tribal roll, and decided to wait until we hear further from area office as to which Tribe she wishes to be enrolled with.

A motion was made by Althea Schuyler to approve the five birth enrollment as there was a question as to when they had been approved.

Seconded by Eva Danforth. Carried.

The enrollment of Daryl Harvey VanDenBloomer was checked and Council noted that this name was listed on the roll twice.

Motion was made by Irene Moore to have Secretary write to James Skenandore and advise him that there are other Tribal members who could use the lumber he had stored and if he doesn't intend to use this lumber in near future, that he could come under public housing possibly at a later date, and let some one else use this lumber now. Motion seconded by Althea Schuyler. Carried.
