Mr. Vickery explains that the Opportunity Act is a community action program involving representatives of different agencies such as education, unions, political units and others. He goes on to say that this activity is not limited to County lines since our Oneida community involves two counties. He invites Chairman Norbert Hill to the next meeting to be held in Green Bay, Wis. to represent our Oneida Community.

Mr. Potter, from the Ashland Agency was next called on to speak. He gave us the Indian Bureau's role in helping to make this Act a success. He believes our community would be more successful in working with the local area group than to try and go it alone. This speech was followed with a discussion and questions by those present.

Chairman Norbert Hill invited Mr. Vickery to attend our Tribal meeting to be held at the Oneida Methodist Hall on Jan. 4, 1965 to explain the Opportunity Act to the Tribal members. He accepts the invitation.

Mr. Potter takes pictures of those present at this meeting to be put in the paper put out by the Ashland Agency Office.
