Reading of minutes of December 16, 1964 and the General Tribal Council meeting on January 4, 1965. Motion by Althea to accept the minutes as read. Seconded by Woodrow Webster. Motion carried.

Eldred Nicholas makes a request for a loan of \$200.00 Althea Schuyler explains that he must see Mrs. Vivian DeCoteau who is on the committee for approving of loans and that there is a waiting list. Mr. Nicholas says if he cannot get the money in two months he will be working again and will not have time to work on the house and he offers to sell his house so he can move off the tribal land. There was a discussion on possible places Mr. Nicholas might be able to get lumber on his own credit.

Howard Elm asked for a clearer explanation of a letter he received from Mr. Riley concerning insurance on Mr. Elm's parent's home which burned down some years ago. The insurance money was turned over to the tribe since his occurred on redeemed land. Mrs. Irene Moore explained to Mr. Elm the difference between redeemed land and tribal lands.
