Motion by Joycelyn Ninham to request Green Bay Human Rights Commission to do as they see fit in regard to Oneida versus D.C. Eagles discriminatory publicity. Second by Ira Cornelius. Motion carried.

Motion by Joycelyn Ninham to send letter to the Green Bay Press Gazette editor to be printed in the Peoples Forum in regard to the bad publicity. Second by Ira Cornelius. Motion carried.

Motion by Joycelyn Ninham to send a letter to the Brown County Chronicle describing the real situation concerning the disturbance between the Oneidas and the D.C. Eagles. Second by Ira Cornelius. Motion carried.

It was suggested that copies of the letter be sent to the Green Bay Commission on Human Rights c/o Mrs. Adkins and the National Congress of American Indians.

Ira Cornelius made a motion to continue until a later date. Second by Joycelyn Ninham. Motion carried.
