The meeting convened at 8:15 p.m.

Joycelyn Ninham made a motion to dispense with the regular order of business. Second by Amelia Cornelius. Motion carried.

Joycelyn Ninham made a motion to accept resolution 68-14, concerning the combining of two leases for Norman and Carol Elm. Second by Amelia Cornelius, motion carried.

Joycelyn Ninham made a motion to accept the resolution to cause unclaimed annuity funds to be restored to tribal ownership. Second Amelia Cornelius, motion carried.

Joycelyn Ninham made a motion to award the contract to lowest bidder for construction on the Industrial Site, providing the city donates the 4.475 acres valued at \$13,500.00 to the tribe, and that the tribe will raise \$10,000.00 from other sources. Second Irene Moore. Motion carried.

The meeting was adjourned at 9:00 p.m. and reconvened at the Administration Building at Seymour for discussion on purchasing the school building. A price was not reached at this time. The district wants \$28,900. It was decided to allow the tribe to use building until the 15<sup>th</sup> of March on basis the tribe pay for utilities. At this time a decision on the purchase price for building must be arrived at in order to continue use of school building.

Motion to adjourn until later date, second and carried.
