BUSINESS CONDUCTED:

Father Kiefer discussed the Bus. Now that the Tribe has a tax-exempt number the Sacred Heart Seminary will transfer title of the Bus to the Tribe. Jerry Hill will check out how this is to be done.

Mr. Rydsdale went over the bylaws of the Oneida Tribal Fund with the Business Committee. Norbert Hill moved to adopt the bylaws as amended. Irene Moore seconded. Motion carried.

Norbert Hill moved that regular monthly meetings of the Oneida Tribal Fund be held immediately preceeding the second monthly meeting of the usiness Committee. Irene Moore seconded. Motion carried.

Norbert Hill moved to adjourn the meeting of the Oneida Tribal Fund Irene Moore seconded. Meeting adjourned.

The Chairman called the meeting of the Business Committee to order.

First order of business was to recommend someone for the position of Community Worker. Norbert Hill moved that the Secretary cast one unanimous vote for Caroline Nicholas. Irene Moore seconded. Motion carried.

There were two applicants for the Health Coordinator position. Audrey Doxtator and Ann Micikalski. Irene Moore moved to accept Loretta Ellis vote in absentia. Alma Webster seconded. Motion carried, 3 for, 1 abstain Audrey Doxtator was selected unanimously.

Irene Moore moved to use Title 11 money for the Building Manager position. Norbert Hill seconded. Motion carried.

Discussion of ONAP program. Norbert Hill moved to designate Carlton Smith as Park Developer for 8 month, to be paid out of ONAP, due to the urgency of getting the ONAP program completed. He would start the 1st of August. Irene Moore seconded. Motion carried.

Norbert Hill moved that the 701 Planners and the Tribal Manager work together on working out the necessary job descriptions for the ONAP program. Irene Moore seconded. Motion carried.
