There was a discussion of the memo from the Commissioner of Indian Affairs, regarding the distribution of Judgement Funds.

The Trust Committee will meet at 2040 W. Wisconsin Ave., Milwaukee, Wed. Sept. 25, at 7:00 p.m. with Mr. Mike Bills, the Attorney for the Trust Committee of the First National Bank of Milwaukee.

The Trust Committee will meet at the Tribal Building Friday Sept. 27, at 7:00 p.m. and on October 8 at the Tribal Building at 1:00 p.m. This meeting will be with BIA officials and the Commissioner of Indian Affairs

Chairman Powless called the Business Committee to order. The Education Committee recommended James Radey for Director of Study Skills Center. Norbert Hill moved to concur with the recommendation of the Education Committee. Irene Moore seconded. Motion carried.

There was a discussion of carry-over funds from GLITC in the amount of \$43,650. Oneida was excluded from sharing this money. Loretta Ellis made a motion the Tribal Manager pursue this matter. Irene Moore seconded. Motion carried.

There was discussion of the Housing Authority selecting the Wisconsin Indian Development Corporation. Irene Moore moved that Loretta Ellis write up a resolution requesting the Housing Authority to reconsider their choice, if the contract has not already been completed. Norbert Hill seconded. Motion carried.

Norbert Hill moved to adjourn. Irene Moore seconded. Meeting adjourned.
