Blue Grass Festival Request: Approximately 15,000 people attended Mole Lake 1975 4th of July weekend requested. Need about 100 acres of land - some woods, some cleared, concession private or tribal land. Rental of land - percentage of profits. Sonny King will check out sites.

Education: Amelia Cornelius moved to adopt Resolution 11-15-76-A to recommend BIA that Higher Education funds be based on need and that 100% of F.Y. allotment be sent to tribe. Seconded by Norbert Hill and carried.

Request to attend Minneapolis Area. *Ron Skunadore*

Joy Ninham moved to approve request of Ruth Utschig to assume duties and pay of Employment Assistance Director retroactive to October 1, 1976. Motion seconded and carried.

Amelia Cornelius moved to set November 30 as deadline for Employment Assistance position. Seconded and carried.

Amelia Cornelius moved to approve Resolution 11-15-76-B for seeking funds for Carl Smith position from BIA. Seconded and approved and carried.

Rick Hill moved to approve Carl Smith's report for October. Seconded and carried.

Community Health Center report - Audrey Doxtator reported Thursday the Swine Flu Clinic, 217 were vaccinated. November 16, 1976 Swine Flu Clinic - Wednesday 6-9 p.m.

Commission on Aging - Audrey Dextator Alma Webster moved to approve the Oneida Reservation Commission on Aging By-Laws. Seconded and carried.

Discussion on Oneida Tri-Council Constitution and By-Laws and meeting in Syracuse, NEW York.

Problem with recognizing the other Canadian & New York, Oneida groups as to which group is the official recognized group. Oneida Business Committee should not get involved with internal disputes of other Oneida groups.

Joy Ninham moved to approve Library report and approve request of additional funding in amount of \$875.00. Seconded and carried.

Alma Webster moved to approve Library contract in amount of \$12,000. Bro. Co. \$4,000., Outagamie County \$4,000, Oneida Tribe \$4,000. Seconded and Carried.

Joy Ninham moved to accept Ruth Baird's resignation from Oneida Business Committee. Seconded and carried.

Joy Ninham moved to table N.C.A.I. report until representative is present. Seconded and carried.

Land - Norbert Hill moved to approve lease for Ron & Beverly King and Leon Smith, Murray Skenandore at 1/2 fair rental. Seconded and carried.

Motion to approve the land application of Kathy Lucas site to be turned over to Housing Authority. Seconded and carried.

Refer request of Howard Cannon to be paid for survey work for Housing.

Amelia Cornelius motion to cancel Glen Jordan homesite lease at Ridgeland based on 2 year permanent residence. Seconded and carried.

Amelia Cornelius to approve homesite lease of John Webster for Glen Jordan site. Seconded and carried.

Joy Ninham moved to approve the enrollment of 54 Oneida. Seconded and carried.

Rick Hill moved to have Norbert Hill pursue IRA monies for land acquisition. Seconded and carried.

Amelia Cornelius moved to table *Treas.* Report. Seconded and carried.

Rick Hill moved to pay bills. Seconded and carried.
