




Oneidas bringing several hundred bags of corn to Washington's starving army at Valley Forge, after the colonists had consistently refused to aid them.

Meeting was informational in nature and began at 1:35 p.m. The first item of discussion concerned the opening of the Museum. There is a punch list of 19 items to be done and six of those items have been given a priority rating for reasons of security and safety. It was Bob's request to have those six items done. Cost of materials would be \$2015 and would require approximately 300 manhours of labor to complete. There wasn't a dollar amount assigned to the manhours because of variables.

Discussion ensued about finding other funding sources. Bob indicated that funding is available but only to museums already in operation which is why it is important that our museum be opened as soon as possible.

Some of the construction problems of the Museum were cited and it was indicated that the majority of those are cosmetic in nature.

Meeting was called to order at 2:30 p.m. Mark made a motion to honor Bob Smith's request for \$2015 for materials and 300 manhours as requested Norbert seconded. Vote was 3 for and 1 opposed. Motion carried.

Other discussion concerned the need for roof repair at the Archiquette Building. The Business Committee took action at a special meeting held on November 29 to direct ITAC to do the repair job. Jerry Fischer indicated that the work should be done by a professional roofer because it requires the hot tar process to be repaired correctly.

Motion by Norbert to adjourn. Seconded by Pat. Meeting adjourned at 2:40 p.m.
