## Informational meeting with Seminole delegation.

Met with B.J. Williams, and Anthony Bruno of Indian Investment Corporation. Planning Office had sent a letter to Stephan Whilden of the Seminole Tribe of Florida, listing the current projects for which development capital is needed. Mr. Bruno stated they were not interested mainly in loaning money, they dealt mostly with management contracts. They would expect about an 18% return on any investment. Management contracts to run no longer than five years, depending on the amount of money invested.

Their Corporation has worked with Indian tribes in California and Arizona. There was discussion of cigarettes, liquor and casinos. They would be interested in projects that would make a quick return on their money. The Planners were showing them around. Ms. Williams and Mr. Bruno will take information back to their Corp; if interested they will send a proposal to the Business Committee.
