Francis distributed a packet of information pertaining to what the Law Office is involved in at the present time.

1. Informational only, letters of communication from Mr. Bukowski on the informational meeting to be held on April 29, 1981 at Southwest High School, at 7:00 P.M.

Discussion on the job description for a Title Searcher, Francis stated a lot of research has been done, but it was done in the wrong way.

2. Cigarette Sales: Francis stated the area distributors want to sell to Indian Tribes. Re. Prosser is drafting legislation to be introduced which would change the structure of the Wisconsin Use Tax, where Indian Tribes would have to pre-collect a tax on sales to non-Indians. If the Bill is passed, lobbying will have to be done.

3. Docket 301: All documentation has been submitted for Francis being the Attorney of Record for Docket 301.

4. Meeting with Six Nations: Francis requested a special meeting to discuss if the Tribe wants to meet with the Six Nations. Meeting has been scheduled for Monday, April 13, 1981, at 9:00 A.M. at the Tribal Building.

5. Shirley Hill letter: Informational.

6. Bingo: Francis stated they have not amended the Motion naming the Brown County Officials as parties and defendants in the case, this will be done in the near future. Discussion on bingo.
