




Oneidas bringing several hundred bags of corn to Washington's starving army at Valley Forge, after the colonists had consistently refused to aid them.

EMPLOYMENT RECOMMENDATION - SNACK BAR ATTENDANT/BINGO/TEMPORARY


Mark made a motion to approve the recommendation of Lisa Ness as temporary Snack Bar Attendant. Norbert seconded. Motion carried.
