Continuing Education - Need to support students in critical professions
Accounting, Management, Educators, Health Fields, etc.

Future Planning - Economic Development, Governmental growth -- need
coordination and cooperation.

Immediate Need - Increased population in elementary level - 7 & 8 grade is
tapering as students drop out to go to public schools.

Oneida Language is being preserved but not being spoken or used.

Business Committee needs to become more involved in recognition and support of
language.

High School - Look at vocational training.


Need to have incentives to teach language.
