E & EE GENERAL CONTRACTOR


The two general contractors, Howard Immel and Life Time Structures have submitted revised prices for the proposed project. Items were deleted and added from both contractors in order that each were quoting on the same building.

Life Time's price is \$104,500
Howard Immel is 109,000

Based on these figures and our review of each contractor's ability to perform, it is our recommendation that we be approved to enter into final contract negotiation with Life Time Structures.

Ernie Stevens moved to accept the memo from Carl Rasmussen to accept the bid of Lifetime Structures for the construction of E & EE One Stop contingent upon review and approval of the building plans and specifications by the Tribal Building Officials (namely Jerry Kurowski, Butch Rentmeester, Mervin Jordan and Carl Rasmussen), submission of all proposed suppliers and sub-contractors, agreement to a lien waiver submittal, and a 20% retainage, proof on construction performance bond and review of all contract language by the Tribal Law Office. David King seconded. Motion carried.

David King moved to recess, Kathy Hughes seconded. Motion carried.
