A suggestion was made to form a sub-committee to develop a comprehensive list from both the Kalihwisaks list and the Enrollment Office list.

It was suggested that tribal members on the Enrollment office list be contacted to see if they want to be on the Kalihwisaks mailing list.

After much discussion it was concluded that the Enrollment office send out a mailing to all tribal members over age 21 to see if they want their addresses given to the Kalihwisaks for tribal mail and to receive the Kalihwisaks.

The Enrollment office will forward those names and address to the Kalihwisaks of those members who authorize the release of their address.


Other requests:
