UAC is developing accurate cost for operation.

Recommend that UAC contact John Beauchamp for Desert Share Food Program.

Fort Howard is providing some funds to assist UAC in fund raising.

"Fund Raiser" - \$75,000


Julie recommended internal fundraisers for individuals to give to UAC.
