Response to concerns expressed by Career Center.

1. Loretta - looking for training funds for DOE, EPA, Department of Defense to be a part of contracts.

Coordination and cooperation of training programs with Tribe so that ORTEK will not be in competition with the Tribe.

2. Recommend Lou Williams provide wording that ORTEK can use in PR or brochures.

3. Career Center did not reach goal of 35 students through ORTEK. This year's grant calls for 40 students. Need 40 students to show continuity of classes. Need to identify student success rate - either placed in permanent job or become full time student.

Dave Powless requested to be a part of any future budget changes. Mary Pat responded that Washington cut funds without notifying the Career Center.

Lou & Glenn will need to work out budget modifications.

ORTEK program is tailor made for training in environmental research.

4. Proposal to use instruments by ORTEK on shared usage and shared cost. Lou will check regulations to see if this can be done.

5. Lou is totally responsible for grant and all changes must go through him. Highly unlikely that the Federal Government will allow additional funds.

6. Career Center will provide recommendation and Career plan for students who

transfer to ORTEK.

7. Reports are required and can be adjusted according to the time frame of the classes.

OTHER

Mary Pat Cuney - Problem with severe learning difficulties or FAS problem. A staff person has been hired as a personnel person and will work on this issue. Recommend individuals for specific counseling if necessary.

Stipends can be used for hand on type positions.
