Don Denny explained services provided to Retail (see attached memo)

Reduced speciality coffees from 12 flavors to 6.

Will be bringing back more products to Highway 54 store after the Gaming machines are moved. This will take about 4-5 weeks.

Concern for promotional items to be displayed.

Is Retail doing joint development with other stores. Lois said "NO", but she did send a memo to Don Hill last year about providing TA.

Sandy stated that everytime she has requested funds, HUB City has not provided anything.

According to Lois, HUB City does not provide perks to employees.

Comparison with other suppliers.

Requested documentation of other C-store suppliers. There are about 4 other suppliers in the areas.

Discussion on perks, gratuities, gifts to Managers or Directors that may cloud the judgment or decision made by them.

There are a number of promotional items presently on order for various departments.

Tribe needs to develop a policy on solicitation and to establish priority for

seeking funds, OPAC, Pool, etc. Reports need to be made back to Business Committee on the support given.

Suggest annual meeting with major vendors of the Tribe. We need to obtain the policies of the Vendors on donations.

Tribe needs to priority list on donations with who and amount to provide donations.

Maybe each Enterprise should allocate a certain amount of funds to a central area for disbursements and establishments.


Concern for placing slots in the pit areas as Westwind. Retail should refer concerns and suggestions to Gaming. Retail receives a percentage for machines placed in their stores.
