Process: Resolution from Tribe for expansion

- Need to find out if Bureau of Indian Affairs has to approve expansion of grade level and to identify total square footage of new building.
- Projected time frame for construction is on hold.


\$521,000 has been committed for remodeling of the Norbert Hill Center to bring to standard of Fire Codes regulations. Projected cost is \$1-1.5 million.

Bureau of Indian Affairs budget for FY 94 has already been submitted. Tribe will need to lobby for additional funds.

P. L. 299 has been amended and addresses facilitation and permits

Tribe to roll into grant any money targeted for new construction - based on tribal request.
