### MINUTES

Presentation - A culmination of 5 community meetings, 5 internal meetings, and 10 with DOT.

Proposed reroute south of Oneida through Florist Drive and across Duck Creek and over 54 to reconnect with Hwy 54.

Tribe can assist DOT in facilitating relocation, assisting with grants, etc.. Involves use of tribal lands.

Preliminary decision making necessary in order to proceed with Community Development.

Important for Business Committee to begin selecting site for Administration building. The Business Committee needs more specific information from Space study, Environmental, Planning, etc. before making any final decision.

1. Seminary School Site - no longer an option school needs all acreage on this site.
2. Philipsen - limited access, targeted for light manufacturing.
- 3 Erikson - south of NHC near Old Seymour Road. Land Office still negotiating purchase.
4. Vande Walle - needs internal site work, room for expansion.
5. Smits - 191 acres on 172.
6. Puylear - 76 acres on 172.
- 7 Brenwall - 14 acres, possibly too small.

All sites have sewer and water.


