Motion by Amelia Cornelius to give approval to proceed with the configuration of Casino and Hotel as one project to internally coordinate, integrate area that would impact the potential revenue base of both projects and that the final budget is to be developed and presented to the Business Committee within two weeks (April 6, 1993), with a comparison of previous budget, size, etc with the new casino, seconded by Russell Metoxen, motion carried unanimously.


Ernie Stevens, Sr. will provide a statement of work for Jack Sommerville as Project Manager for coordination of both projects.
