1. Town Hall Building - Project Proposal:
\$4,800 - \$150-170,000 estimated cost. Plans include large Town Hall, have 40 acres behind Town Hall for park development. Planned start of construction sometime this year. Need technical assistance to seek funds, like a grants writer.
2. Existing pumper truck is 18 years old. Back up is 1965 Ford. Town has about \$12,000 ear marked. Concern for height of Building is being constructed by Tribe. Julie Barton, Shirley Hill and Russell Metoxen to attend.

2:00 P.M. - LORETTA METOXEN ARRIVED AT MEETING.

Proposal is in Bureau of Indian Affairs, Tribe will need to do lobbying to get action. Pumper is \$130 - \$170,000 depending upon add-on equipment.

3. Building Code Compliance. Would like to open back of present building so trucks can drive through.
4. Approximate cost \$21,000 - Request assistance from Tribe, possible to use Bureau of Indian Affairs funds.

Town need contacts and phone numbers of tribal departments.

5. Water and sewer - Phase III location has not been finalized.

6. Town would need an Ordinance to not issue license for liquor. Tribe could also purchase license and just hold them. Ordinance could be open for supper clubs, golf courses, not just taverns.

Recommend Tribe provide copy of any Ordinance on liquor or similar laws to Town.

Town of Oneida abide by Outagamie County Zoning Ordinance

Town of Osborn has a sreeze ordinance. Need to write for copy.

- 7 Need to know height of any future buildings for future fire needs
8. Culvert/drainage on Poplar Lane: Propose to initiate a study on drainage of tribal lands on a joint government-to-government program. Problem on Poplar Lane goes back to Highway 55. Austin said there is a need for a drainage district with Tribe paying a portion along with the Town.
