5. TO APPROVE THE LONG TERM (1 YEAR) STRATEGY FOR THE NEW YORK DEVELOPMENT UTILIZING THE 1997 PROGRAM, PLAN AND BUDGET.

6. TO APPROVE THE LONG TERM STRATEGY (1 YEAR) FOR THE LAND CLAIMS DEVELOPMENT UTILIZING THE 1997 PROGRAM PLAN, AND BUDGET.
7. TO APPROVE THE IMMEDIATE ASSIGNMENT OF DEVELOPMENT AND LAND CLAIMS STAFF TO COMPLETE THE TASKS OUTLINED ABOVE, AND TO PROVIDE A STATUS REPORT TO THE BUSINESS COMMITTEE BY JUNE 12TH.
