
MOTION BY KATHY HUGHES TO APPROVE THE PARTICIPATION OF THE ONEIDA NATION IN THE MECCA PLAN TO FUND THE ARENA\CONVENTION PROJECT BY ALLOCATING FUNDS IN AN AMOUNT COMMENSURATE WITH A 7% ROOM TAX ALLOCATED TO THE PROJECT WHILE RETAINING 1% FOR NATION INFRASTRUCTURE DEMANDS. FURTHER, THE GENERAL MANAGER AND CHIEF COUNSEL ARE DIRECTED TO DEVELOP THE ORDINANCE AND AGREEMENTS AND RESOLUTION NEEDED TO CARRY OUT THIS PARTICIPATION, SECONDED BY SANDRA NINHAM. SHIRLEY HILL OPPOSED. MOTION CARRIED.

For the Record, Shirley Hill did not support a Convention Center at all and was concerned in regard to the stake holders we had in our community vs. other hotels and that she had a concern to the GTC action in regard to revenues.
