THE INVESTIGATION AND REPORT PRIOR TO OCTOBER 28, 1995 HAS BEEN COMPLETE AND ALL CASES WILL BE REVIEWED THROUGH THE APPROPRIATE PROCESS WITHIN THE ONEIDA TRIBE."
