Meeting called to order at 4:05 p.m.


Motion by David Bischoff that on 10/1/99 the Oneida Business Committee was notified that the Oneida Gaming Commission suspended the Gaming General Manager's license effective 10/1/99. In accordance with Section 1, paragraph 4 of the Oneida Gaming General Manager employment agreement, the Oneida Business Committee took action to terminate the Oneida Gaming General Manager employment agreement effective 10/1/99. Seconded by Judy Cornelius, 0 opposed, 0 abstained. Motion carried unanimously.

Vince DelaRosa moved to appoint David A. Webster as acting Gaming General Manager effective 10/1/99. Judy Cornelius seconded. 0 opposed, 0 abstained, motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Vince DelaRosa to appoint David A. Webster for a period not to exceed six (6) months. Judy Cornelius seconded. 0 opposed, 0 abstained. Motion carried.

Motion by Judy Cornelius to approve the Chairman sending letters to Amelia Cornelius and David A. Webster notifying them of the Business Committee's decision. Seconded by Vince DelaRosa. 0 opposed, 0 abstained. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Vince DelaRosa to adjourn, seconded by Tina Danforth. 0 opposed, 0 abstained. Motion carried unanimously.
