Civil Lawsuit

MOTION BY EUGENE METOXEN TO REFER LILA WATTS REQUEST FOR REPRESENTATION AND COPY OF THE COMPLAINT TO THE ONEIDA GAMING COMMISSION FOR REVIEW AND ACTION, WITH A RESPONSE DUE BACK TO THE BUSINESS COMMITTEE BY WEDNESDAY, JUNE 5, 2002, SECONDED BY DAVID BISCHOFF. TINA DANFORTH, JUDY CORNELIUS, VINCE DELAROSA OPPOSED. MOTION CARRIED.


GTC Wage Petition:
