

- WHEREAS,** the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin is a federally recognized Indian government and a treaty tribe recognized by the laws of the United States, and
- WHEREAS** the Oneida General Tribal Council is the governing body of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, and
- WHEREAS** the Oneida Business Committee has been delegated the authority of Article IV, Section 1 of the Oneida Tribal Constitution by the Oneida General Tribal Council, and
- WHEREAS,** the Oneida Tribe has determined as part of its Seventh Generation Commitment, "To develop a provisional system that fits our "family"/community values such as food, shelter, clothing and employment as well as other services," and
- WHEREAS,** the Oneida Tribe has established the Oneida Social Services/Center for Self-Sufficiency to promote quality educational, employment and support services for needy Indian families, and
- WHEREAS,** the Oneida Tribe with the collaboration of the United States Department of Health and Human Services/Compassion Capital fund Targeted Capacity-Building Program would like to provide quality, culturally appropriate shelter services to homeless Indian youth and families on or near the Oneida Reservation, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: That the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin/Center for Self-Sufficiency in collaboration with the United States Department of Health and Human Services/Office of Community Services/A.C.F./Compassion Capital Fund Targeted Capacity-Building Program authorizes and submits this grant application to support homeless youth and families on or near the Oneida Reservation.
