Motion by Brian Doxtator to adopt resolution 8-10-05-A, for the 2006 FY

Budget, seconded by Curtis Danforth. Vince DelaRosa opposed. Motion

carried.

For the record, Vince DelaRosa opposed due to the structure of the LOC Budget. He has deep concerns with its under funding.

For the record, Tina Danforth opposed this taking place in this forum because she felt it should have gone to GTC and rescheduled at the GTC level. Not only because of the wage adjustment consideration, but because it's the nation's budget, not the Business Committee's budget.

Brian Doxtator, Curtis Danforth abstained. Motion carried.
