I am writing in response to your correspondence dated February 26, 2013. The Village of Hobart certainly has no intention of doing anything in violation of Judge Griesbach's Order. I will be out of the office March 7th and 8th, however, I wanted to at least provide you with a partial response at this time.

I am not aware of the Village making any attempts to collect on any stormwater fees on trust parcels since Judge Griesbach's decision. I am currently looking into what steps the County may have taken in regard to the stormwater fees. Please note that I have forwarded a copy of Judge Griesbach's decision to Brown County. I believe the County's already aware of the decision but, to the extent it is not, I am providing an actual copy.
