What is 4-H?

4-H is a family affair where youth and adults get together to learn new things, meet new friends, and have fun. The four H's stand for Head-Heart-Hands-Health, and signify the development of the whole person. The purpose of 4-H is to provide real-life experiences for youth through a fun and practical learn-by-doing, educational program and to provide opportunities for adults to work with youth in their development. Our county has a large and active 4-H program. We welcome boys and girls from both rural and urban homes. Members are youth in grades 3-13 (one year after high school) and cloverbuds are youth in kindergarten-grade 2.

What's in it for me?

Youth learn skills in 4-H to use their whole lifetime! In each 4-H project youth learn to set goals, organize their time, complete tasks, evaluate their work and keep records. In Outagamie County, over 500 adults volunteer their time for 4-H. When a child is active in 4-H, **the whole family** spends quality time together. Parents play a big part in helping their children have a successful 4-H experience. Younger siblings can enjoy 4-H too, and are welcome at most meetings and activities. 4-H is family fun.
