

Oneida Juvenile Services

The Juvenile Services Program assist youth who are struggling in school, home or other community settings. The program will assist in juvenile cases being presented in Brown and Outagamie County Courts or county juvenile service programs. The Oneida Juvenile Services Program will focus on the family as a whole and as part of the community. The program will work to strengthen youth and their families through the use of cultural and traditional values.

Currently there is one Juvenile Services Case Manager who provides the following services:

- *Outreach services to adjudicated delinquent, pre-delinquent youth and their families*
- *Provide home visits*
- *Problem assessment*
- *Link individuals to other services as needed*
- *Send referrals to appropriate county agencies when child abuse or neglect is suspected*
- *Network with county and private sector agencies*
- *Encourage youth to participate in community and cultural activities*
- *Provide individual and group prevention activities*
