GENERAL TRIBAL COUNCIL RESOLUTION # 1-6-92 B

WHEREAS, the Oneida General Tribal Council is the duly recognized governing body of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee may be delegated duties and responsibilities by the Oneida General Tribal Council and is at all times subject to the review powers of the Oneida General Tribal Council, and

WHEREAS, the General Tribal Council ordered that \$125,000 of the FY'90 budget be used to assist Tribal Home Owners with well and septic problems, and

WHEREAS, Facilities Construction Manager, Gerald Kurowski, only used \$38,905.43 even though many Tribal Home Owners had septic systems that were backing up and many Oneidas needed wells.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: that the entire fund budgeted for well and septic problems for FY 1991 be a priority and shall all be used.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: that in the event that the Oneida Employee crew does not have time or equipment, all the funds shall be used for those person in need. The work shall be contracted to outside contractors.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: that this Special Fund may not be used other than for private well and septic for Tribal Home Owners.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED: that septic systems that have to be pumped continuously be served first.
