




Oneidas bringing several hundred bags of corn to Washington's starving army at Valley Forge, after the colonists had consistently refused to aid them.

ONEIDA GENERAL TRIBAL COUNCIL RESOLUTION NO. 1-8-83-B

WHEREAS, The Oneida General Tribal Council is the duly recognized governing body of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin; and,

WHEREAS, The Oneida Business Committee may be delegated duties and responsibilities by the Oneida General Tribal Council and is at all times subject to the review powers of the Oneida General Tribal Council; and,

WHEREAS, The Oneida General Tribal Council in session has deemed it necessary to authorize spending by the Oneida Business Committee and the Oneida Tribal Treasurer; and,

WHEREAS, A resolution is required under the Oneida Constitution from the Oneida General Tribal Council authorizing day to day expenditures pending a full budget review, and passage approving the FY '83 Oneida Tribal budget.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the General Tribal Council authorizes the Oneida Business Committee to expend Tribal funds in accordance with the attached FY '83 budget and the Oneida Constitution.
