

Resolution 12-69  
July 7, 1969

Whereas, the resolution of Feb. 20, 1949 has been rescinded, and

Whereas, the business transacted is for and on behalf of the tribal membership, the General Tribal Council should have the final voice, and

Whereas, it is often difficult to obtain a quorum to transact business,

Therefore be it resolved, that the powers under Article IV-A., B., C., D., E., and F. be delegated to the Executive Committee in accordance with G. and H. of Article IV in the Constitution and Bylaws with the exception that no more than \$1200.00 be spent for one express purpose without the direct consent of the General Tribal Council, also that the word review as used in Article IV-G be defined to mean change or amend, whichever is deemed necessary by the General Tribal Council.
