GENERAL TRIBAL COUNCIL RESOLUTION GTC 8-19-95-C

- WHEREAS,** the Oneida General Tribal Council is the duly recognized governing body of the Oneida Tribe of Indian of Wisconsin,
- WHEREAS,** the Oneida Business Committee may be delegated duties and responsibilities by the Oneida General Tribal Council and is at all times subject to the review powers of the Oneida General Tribal Council, and
- WHEREAS,** the General Tribal Council has been delegated the authority of Article IV, Section I of the Oneida Tribal Constitution, and
- WHEREAS,** there are many Oneida Tribal members who would like to relocate to the Oneida, WI area, but cannot cover the cost of relocating, and
- WHEREAS,** the Oneida Tribe can afford to help Tribal members to relocate to Oneida.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Oneida Tribe shall develop an account to offer financial assistance to Oneidas who wish to relocate to Oneida. This shall be in addition to the fund to relocate new hired employees who are tribal members.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Oneida Business Committee shall research funds and designate and delegate the department that will be responsible to carry this out.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Oneida Business Committee develop a Comprehensive Plan available Fiscal year 1996.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that this will be for enrolled members of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin.
