RESOLUTION GTC #11-16-92-A

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin is a federally recognized Indian government and a treaty tribe recognized by the laws of the United States, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida General Tribal Council is the governing body of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee has been delegated the authority of Article IV, Section 1 of the Oneida Tribal Constitution by the Oneida General Tribal Council, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe is in a state of extremely high growth rate, and

WHEREAS, space needs for an administration building, Oneida Tribal School, Day Care Facilities and Gaming Expansion are critical and are currently being planned for the inclusion of financial considerations, and

WHEREAS, Gaming revenues makes up approximately 86% of the total income for the Oneida Tribe, and

WHEREAS, the legal and legislative support have increased substantially and will continue to do so throughout F.Y. '93, and

WHEREAS, the General Tribal Council requires a definitive budget for consideration for final approval,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the proposed final budget is presented to the General Tribal Council for their review and discussion at the General Tribal Council meeting on November 16, 1992, and

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the FY '93 budget is adopted by General Tribal Council on November 16, 1992.
