FY2000 Gaming Budget


- Whereas** the Oneida General Tribal Council is the duly recognized governing body of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, and
- Whereas** the General Tribal Council is the highest authority under the Constitution of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, and
- Whereas** the Oneida Business Committee is delegated duties and responsibilities by the Oneida General Tribal Council and is at all times subject to the review powers of the Oneida General Tribal Council, and
- Whereas** the Oneida Business Committee has the fiscal responsibility of preparing a budgetary plan for review and approval by the Oneida General Tribal Council, and
- Whereas** the Oneida Gaming Management has prepared a comprehensive plan encompassing the total needs of the Gaming Operation with a balance remaining for distribution to the General Fund, and

**Now therefore be it resolved**, that the Oneida General Tribal Council hereby adopts this fiscal plan for the Oneida Gaming Operation Fiscal year 2000 as detailed in the attached documents resulting in an estimated distribution to the General Fund of \$72,992,247 with review and oversight by the Oneida Business Committee with the following guidelines:

1. Modification, adjustments and/or deletions in excess of \$100,000 will require General Tribal Council approval.
