

What Types of Cases Can the Trial Court Hear?

The Oneida Trial Court has the authority to hear the following types of cases:

1. Election Disputes
2. Housing Violations
3. Evictions
4. Small Claims (\$5,000 or less)
5. Contract or Leasing Disputes
6. Wage Garnishments (monies owed by Tribal employees)
7. Tribal Debt (monies owed to the Tribe by a Tribal member)
8. Per Capita Attachments (Child Support, Tribal Debt, Federal Tax Levy)
9. Disinterment
10. Civil matter injunctions or Temporary Restraining Orders (TRO)
11. Workers Compensation Disputes
12. Indian Preference Disputes
13. Other cases where Tribal laws specifically authorize the Court to exercise jurisdiction
