


JULY IS FIREWORK SAFETY MONTH!

- ❖ Wear safety glasses when shooting fireworks.
- ❖ Always have a bucket of water, and charged water hose, nearby.
- ❖ Dispose of spent product by wetting it down and place it in a metal trash can away from any building or combustible materials until morning.
