All meeting minutes are submitted to the Tribal Secretary's office as they are approved.

ACTION TAKEN:

1. We have held open regular monthly meetings in accordance with the Law Enforcement Ordinance.
2. We have approved and completed hiring process for one additional officer. We are still in need of Dispatchers and Sergeants. In addition we will be hiring three more officers over the next year due to retirements.
3. We are pleased to report that we have approved the signing of a cross deputization agreement with Outagamie County Sherriff Department. All officers are now cross deputized with both Brown and Outagamie County.
4. The Commission has attended several meetings with the Business Committee, Staff and Community over the past few months regarding Gangs within our Community. We appreciate everyone's support and contribution as we work towards addressing the safety and wellness needs of the Community. The Community Action Team has made forward progress in opening a youth outreach center now located at Ridge View Suite 7. The new center focuses on credit recovery and will be adding life skills in the near future. We are currently working on an additional referral system.

FINANCIAL:

Our approved budget for FY 14 is \$100,000. We are currently operating within our budgeted projections for the current fiscal year.



