Native American Family Caregiver Voucher/Stipend Program





Caregiver Definition:

An adult family member, or another individual who is an informal provider to an older individual or to an individual with Alzheimer's disease or a related disorder with neurological and organic brain dysfunction. When a dependency situation emerges this person(s) performs tasks designed to assist an individual with routine activities that were previously performed without assistance.

Grandparents or relative caregivers, age 55 and older, who are the primary caregiver of a child no more than 18 years old. They must be related to the child by blood, marriage, or adoption and must live with the child.

Respite care is provided to the primary caregiver for a break from their caregiving responsibilities during regular business hours through Elder Services Monday – Friday 8:00 am – 4:30 p.m.

Respite Relief Caregiver Definition:

Family or friend who is approved through Elder Services to provide relief to the primary caregiver.

Eligibility Requirements for Voucher/ Stipend Payment:

- Respite Relief Caregiver must be pre-approved.
- Recipient or caregivers must be Native American, 55 or older.
- Approved background check from Oneida Tribe of Indians.
- Required forms:
 - Voucher Application
 - Provider Agreement
 - Voucher Invoice
- Completed forms are submitted to Native American Family Caregiver.
